## Can't leave home without!

- Passports
- Boarding passes
- Transfers (Airport Shuttle)
- Resort confirmation

## Medical:

- Any prescriptions you require (best to keep in your carry-on)
- Pain killers (drinking has its consequences)
- Immunity boosters like Airborne, Echinacea, etc... (you're traveling on planes and may be in "close" contact with other people for a week)
